*Freedom . . . It's What We All Long For!*

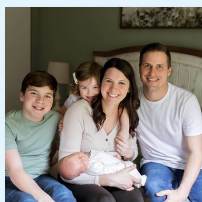

Missy Townsend has been singing in church since she was five years old. She has travelled extensively nationally and internationally as a worship leader.



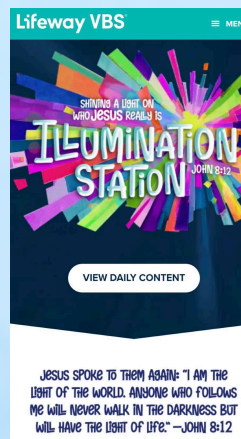
Missy has served as a worship leader for women's retreats and district conferences for more than 20 years. Missy returns to White River once again to help usher us into the presence of God.



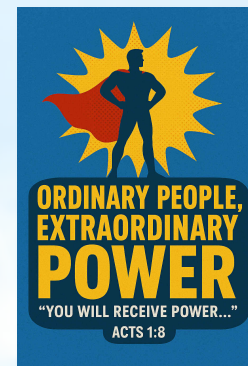
### Heather Traudt - Kid's Program
